

9 Patch Pizzazz - Fill'er Up Class

DESCRIPTION:

Using a large print, or your own blocks, learn how to fill in around those to make a larger, more interesting quilt. Using 9 patches and 4 patches, we will make the colors flow across the quilt top.

SUPPLY LIST:

Bring a camera, if you have one.

Sheet or flannel or big piece of fabric to put the project on.

Olfa cutter, mat, ruler, and if you have a 12 ½" square and a 6 ½ square, that would be helpful, but not necessary.

To start the project, either 2 ½ yards of a large print OR several blocks to go together into the quilt top.

Then bring coordinating fabrics that are ½ yard to 1 yard pieces. Bring about 10 to 15 so you can mix the colors up. (More if you want to carry them.)

Sewing machine, threads, bobbins, scissors, pins, extension cord, iron and mat. Some people can share, not everyone has to bring an iron. Other sewing items that you normally use should also be brought.
