Located in Maryville, Tennessee, the campus of Maryville College is nestled in the foothills between the Great Smoky Mountains National Park and Tennessee’s third largest city. Just 15 miles from downtown Knoxville and 5 miles from McGhee Tyson Airport, the campus is near the convergence of Interstates 40, 75 and 81 making it within a day’s drive of two-thirds of our nation’s population.

The area is rich in quilting tradition and embraces the styles and techniques of prior generations as well as the innovative approaches of contemporary art quilters. Smoky Mountain Quilters of Tennessee serves more than 200 members and is only one of several area quilt guilds, many of which produce their own annual or biennial quilt shows. SMQT volunteers lend assistance to the American Quilters Society each July in producing Knoxville’s AQS Expo event.

Since 1980, our goals have been to promote and showcase both the artistic and technical abilities of quilt makers from all over our country and beyond its shores. We also encourage emerging quilters no matter what age they choose to thread their first needles whether hand held or in a machine. Our entries are not juried, however we depend on the services of highly trained and certified professional judges to evaluate the quilts and award the efforts of our entrants.

Our ample exhibit space is completely climate controlled with good lighting. Viewers will be able to examine the quilts and shop with a variety of vendors in the immediate vicinity. They will also enjoy shopping for small quilts created by our members. Merikay Waldvogel, Quilter’s Hall of Fame inductee in 2009, will present bed turnings at scheduled intervals during the show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The quilts in this competition are not juried and are accepted on a first come, first served basis. Quilts will be judged for overall appearance, construction techniques, color, design and quilting stitch. Ribbons will be given to all winners, and cash prizes will be awarded to Best of Show–Bed Quilt, Best of Show–Wall Quilt, and First, Second and Third place winners in each category. A variety of special awards will also be given. Your quilt's safety and security are important to us. The quilts will be shown at Cooper Athletic Center on the campus of Maryville College in Maryville, Tennessee. White gloved attendants will be on hand during viewing hours, and the building is secured when the event is closed.

CATEGORIES

- A. Bed Quilts, Pieced and Quilted— Suitable for use on a bed; perimeter exceeds 264 inches, with smallest side a minimum of 60 inches.
- B. Bed Quilts, Mixed Techniques or Appliquéd and Quilted— Suitable for use on a bed; perimeter exceeds 264 inches, with smallest side a minimum of 60 inches.
- C. Wall Quilts, Pieced and Quilted— Designed for hanging as a wall display.
- D. Wall Quilts, Appliquéd and/or Mixed Techniques and Quilted— Designed for hanging as a wall display.
- E. Lap Quilts — Designed to be used as a lap quilt; any technique qualifies. Perimeter is 264 inches or less.
- F. Art Quilts— These quilts are expected to be entirely original in design, produced with creative thought and without replicating the work of others. They also exceed tradition in construction and appearance.
- G. Small Pictorial— A quilt that illustrates a recognizable image (for example: animals, people, floral, landscapes, etc.); perimeter of 160 inches or less.
- H. Large Pictorial— A quilt that illustrates a recognizable image (for example: animals, people, floral, landscapes, etc.); perimeter exceeds 160 inches.
- I. Miniature— Utilizing the design elements and techniques of a full size quilt, this entry is scaled to miniature proportions; not to exceed 24 inches per side.
- J. Kids— Made for use on a child's bed.
- K. Other— Quilt entries that do not fit into any of the categories previously listed. Included in this category are: yo-yo, cathedral window, crazy quilts (tied), whole cloth, hand embroidered quilts, kit quilts and block-of-the-month patterns/kits.
- L. Machine Embroidered Quilts — Main components of these quilts feature machine embroidery techniques; perimeter to exceed 160 inches.
- M. Junior— Quilt made entirely by an individual, age 21 or younger; not judged. Participation ribbon only.
- N. Two Person Team, Pieced –Small— Two quilters work on the quilt; includes quilt for hire; perimeter is less than 240 inches.
- O. Two Person Team, Appliquéd/Mixed –Small— Two quilters work on the quilt; includes quilt for hire; perimeter is less than 240 inches.
- P. Two Person Team, Pieced –Large— Two quilters work on the quilt; includes quilt for hire; perimeter is 240 inches or greater.
- Q. Two Person Team, Appliquéd/Mixed –Large— Two quilters work on the quilt; includes quilt for hire; perimeter is 240 inches or greater.
- R. Group— Any quilt created by members of a creative team of three or more quilters.
- S. SMQ Members Only Challenge — This category is open only to active SMQ members and is a theme challenge.

RULES

- ◆ Entries must be quilted unless otherwise specified.
- ◆ Quilt is defined as three layers: top (fabric), batting and backing (fabric).
- ◆ Entry must be completely constructed and quilted by the individual on the entry form except for quilts entered in Group or Two Person.
- ◆ All persons who worked on the quilt must be listed on the entry form (design, construction, quilting, etc.) If not an original design, credit must be given.
- ◆ All entries must hang for the duration of the show and may not be removed for any reason prior to designated pick up time.
- ◆ No special hanging requirements and no rigid framing allowed; quilts may be folded during handling.
- ◆ Entries must arrive clean, undamaged and odor free.
- ◆ SMQT reserves the right to reject, reclassify or not display inappropriate entries (soiled, damaged, misrepresented, unqualified, etc.)
- ◆ Entry fees for entries that are disqualified or not delivered are non-refundable.
- ◆ The judge will have the final say in disputes involving categories and reserves the right to not award all of the ribbons/prizes.
- ◆ Quilts must have been completed in the last five years.
- ◆ Previous entries in SMQT shows are not allowed.
- ◆ Quilts without proper LABELS and HANGING SLEEVES will not be accepted.
- ◆ Entries are limited to maximum of five entries per entrant and one per category. (Based on ownership of the quilt.)
- ◆ Perimeter is equal to the sum of the quilt's four sides.
