## 8-BEAR PAW

Cutting Instructions:
Fabric A
$4-51 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 4 "}$
$1-8^{1 / 2 "} \times 8^{1 / 2 "}$
Fabric B
$4-51 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 4 "}$
$1-41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1 / 2 "}$

Collect your cut fabrics.
Draw diagonal lines across the backs of the $51 / 4$ " light colored squares, from one corner to the other.

Place a light square on top of a dark square, right sides together.
Stitch on the line.
Trim away one side, leaving a quarter inch seam allowance.
Open, pressing seam allowance towards the dark.
Repeat for remaining three sets.
Square up the four squares to $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Arrange all the units into a bear paw shape.
Stitch the two side units together, using a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance.
Stitch the top three units together.
Stitch the two side units to the large square.
Stitch the bottom to the top.
Your block is complete!
