


Big Block Square Quilt

finishes 42 x 42 inches

We used this to showcase a limited number of fussy cut squares from a large print.





Fabric width 44-45 inches	Number of patches	Yardage estimate

CUT:

FEATURE PRINT (BLACK in this case) – cut 9 6.5 x6.5 inch squares

Blue cut 8 6.5 x 6.5 inch squares and 8 3.5 x 6.5 inch rectangles

Black and white cut 4 6.5 x 6.5 inch squares and 8 3.5 x 6.5 inch rectangles

Red cut 4 6.5 x 6.5 inch squares
4 3.5 x 6.5 inch rectangles and 4 3.5 x 3.5 inch squares

Borders cut 2 Horizontal – 42.5 x 3.5 inches

2 Vertical 36.5 x 3.5

SEWING: We recommend laying out all the blocks to see that they are well arranged before you sew.

Be careful about directional prints.

Sew pieces in rows, consulting picture if needed. Join rows, matching corners.

Sew vertical borders to sides – you can identify the vertical borders because are a few inches shorter than the horizontal border.

Then sew in the longer strips for horizontal border at top and bottom.
