This quilt is scrappy. Yardage will match this list only if you copy the pattern exactly and that isn't important. We had a pretty print for squares and some harmonizing small scraps for frames


Cut each block like this illustration at left. We made all the squares the same fabric and varied the outer frames. You need 30 blocks.

Sew blocks: sew shorter rectangles to square - one on each side. Then sew longer rectangles to top and bottom.

Lay them out, look at them, and get them well distributed - not clumped like my illustration, This is very important with scrappy quilts.

Sew blocks in rows and then join the rows, matching seams.
