## Four-square Chevron Block

Fabrics:

- (2) $4 \times 4$ inch squares one color or pattern
- (2) $4 \times 4$ inch squares of a second color or pattern

1. Cut each square of both fabrics in half diagonally so they form triangles. Assemble the triangles, right side up, in the order they're going in.

2. Fold over each pair of triangles in the squares so the right sides are facing and sew along the long sides. Trim the corners then press open.

3. Sew the top two squares together, right sides facing. Then, sew the bottom two squares together, right sides facing. Press open.
4. Place the top and bottom pieces together, right sides facing. Make sure to line up the center seams before sewing.

5. Press the whole piece using an iron.
