



I SPY QUILT

I spy quilts are made for fun and games.

Start with what your child knows and gradually get harder as he or she grows. You can also spy smaller details as they learn to find things. Here are some examples to get you started:

EASIER

I spy an animal.

I spy a cat.

I spy a car

I spy something that goes MEOW.

HARDER: Add in clues like this as your child learns.

I spy an animal with horns.

I spy something that flies.

How many animals do you see?

How many mouths do you see?

I spy something blue.

Can you point to your favorite color?

I spy something that starts with S.

I spy something that rhymes with fog,

I spy four animals. Can you find them all?

ALSO FOR FUN: Pick one, two, or more squares and make up a story about the picture. As he or she grows, ask your child to make up the stories.
