LINE UP
Finished Quilt is $40 \times 52.5$

There are $\mathbf{8 0}$ squares, all the same color and $\mathbf{8 0}$ rectangles of varied colors.


YARDAGE: 1 yard gives you enough to cut the 80 squares with some extra.

CUT
Cut 73 inch wide strips the width of fabric and remove selvedges. (depending on selvedge and your cutting accuracy, 6 strips may be enough. )

Cut into 80 squares. $3 \times 3$
Cut 80 rectangles from varied fabrics. $3 \times 8$
SEW
Sew one square to each rectangle.
Because this is scrappy, the blocks need be laid out on the floor or design wall before you start sewing the rows. You will probably need to move the blocks around a bit to get a layout that looks well-distributed.

When you have them the way you like, alternate the direction of the strips when you sew the row together. There are 16 strips in each row. Sew all five rows together, matching up the corners.
