## Supplies



Calicoes: three 4-1/2" squares & 6 half square triangles cut from 4-7/8" squares



Color 2: one 4-7/8" x 14-5/8" strip

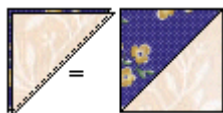
## \*\* Prepare the Pieces & Sew the Block \*\*



For each block, cut three 4-1/2" squares & 6 half square triangles (cut from 4-7/8" squares) ...



Mark & cut a 4-7/8" x 14-5/8" strip of background fabric into three 4-7/8" squares. Stack these squares & cut them once on the diagonal to get 6 half square triangles.



Sew each of the print half square triangles to a background half square triangle, using a 1/4" seam. Press the seam to the darker side. These should measure 4-1/2".



Lay out all your units as shown at left & stitch together into 3 horizontal rows. Press row seams in alternating directions. Sew the rows together & you are done!
