## Supplies

Color 1 needs: one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ strip AND one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$
strip
Color 2 needs: one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square AND one $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 23^{\prime \prime}$ strip
Color 3 needs: one $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 23^{\prime \prime}$ strip AND one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$
strip AND one 2-1/2" $\times 26^{\prime \prime}$ strip

## Preparing the Pieces \& Sew the Block



Start by marking \& cutting the Color $1 \quad 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ strip into four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Then mark \& cut the Color $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 10 " strip into four 2-1/2" squares. Cut ONE $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of Color 2 as well.


Now mark \& cut the Color 2 \& Color 3 2-7/8" x $23^{\prime \prime}$ strips into eight $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares of each. Cut each of these squares in $1 / 2$ once on the diagonal to make 16 half square triangles of each.


Next mark \& cut the Color $32-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ strip into eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Mark \& cut the Color $32-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $26^{\prime \prime}$ strip into four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

NaSew each of the Color 3 half square triangles to a Color 2 half square triangle, right sides together, \& using a SCANT $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Press seam allowances towards the darker fabric.


Sew units of two half squares, making 2 in each arrangement shown at left.持 $=0$ Then sew 4 units as shown at left, made of a Color 1 \& Color 3 2-1/2" square each.


Make 2 of each of the units shown at left, noting that they are made up of the same units, but sewn in a different orientation. Each needs one Color $32-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square \& 2 half squares.

Sew 4 of the units shown at left, using one Color 1 rectangle \& a pair of pre sewn squares.


Make 2 of each of the next units shown at left.


Then piece the block, using the Color 3 long rectangles \& the Color 2 small square as spacers between the units. Make rows, then sew the rows together to complete the block.
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
