

This makes a 14" block!

Supplies



<u>Color 1 needs</u>: one 2-1/2" x 18" strip AND one 2-1/2" x 10" strip



 $\underline{\text{Color 2 needs}}$: one 2-1/2" square AND one 2-7/8" x 23" strip




<u>Color 3 needs</u>: one 2-7/8" x 23" strip AND one 2-1/2" x 20" strip AND one 2-1/2" x 26" strip

Preparing the Pieces & Sew the Block

Start by marking & cutting the Color 1 2-1/2" x 18" strip into four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles. Then mark & cut the Color 1 2-1/2" x 10" strip into four 2-1/2" squares. Cut ONE 2-1/2" square of Color 2 as well.

Now mark & cut the Color 2 & Color 3 2-7/8" x 23" strips into eight 2-7/8" squares of each. Cut each of these squares in ½ once on the diagonal to make 16 half square triangles of each.



eight 2-1/2" squares. Mark & cut the Color 3 2-1/2" x 26" strip into four 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.


Sew each of the Color 3 half square triangles to a Color 2 half square triangle, right sides together, & using a SCANT 1/4" seam. Press seam allowances towards the darker fabric.




Then sew 4 units as shown at left, made of a Color 1 & Color 3 2-1/2" square each.

Make 2 of each of the units shown at left, noting that they are made up of the same units, but sewn in a different orientation. Each needs one Color 3 2- 1/2" square & 2 half squares.

Sew 4 of the units shown at left, using one Color 1 rectangle & a pair of pre sewn squares.



Make 2 of each of the next units shown at left.



Then piece the block, using the Color 3 long rectangles & the Color 2 small square as spacers between the units. Make rows, then sew the rows together to complete the block.

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
