

ROUND ROBIN TIMELINE AND DIRECTIONS FOR EACH ROUND

February 4 – Bring your 12 ½” square. You will put your square, extra fabric, Quilt Recipe page and anything else you would like into your provided box. At the end of the meeting, you will pick up a new box with someone else’s square.

First Round – Add a border to two sides of the square in your box. The borders should measure 3 inches on one side and 5 inches on the other. It does not matter which sides you use. Your two borders should include a square block.

March 3 – Bring the box back with you to the meeting. At the end of the meeting, pick up your next box at the end of the meeting.

Second Round – Add a border to three sides of the square in your box. One border should measure 2 inches, one 4 inches and one 6 inches. You should include at least one triangle in your 3 borders.

April 7 – Bring the box back with you to the meeting. At the end of the meeting, pick up your next box at the end of the meeting.

Third Round – Add one curvy border to your quilt. It should measure 6 inches.

May 5 – Bring the box back with you to the meeting. At the end of the meeting, pick up your next box at the end of the meeting.

Final Round – The final round is completely up to you. Add whatever you feel the quilt needs.

June 2 – Bring your box back and we will reveal everyone’s quilt!
