## HOW TO SEW A STRIP-PIECED HEART QUILT BLOCK

## FABRIC:

Heart: Spring colors - Think "Sweethearts" Candy
Background: White on white print

- Six $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips of fabric

- Four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares of background fabric
- Two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares of background fabric
- Two $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips of background fabric
- Two $11 / 2$ " $\times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips of background fabric

STEP 1: SIX $11 / 2 "$ X $61 / 2 "$ STRIPS OF FABRIC


Sew the red or pink heart strips lengthwise into two sets of three.

## STEP 2:

Mark a diagonal line on the back of each background square.

Lay the background squares on top of the strip sets, right sides together. The smaller squares should be on the top of the heart strip units, while the larger square should be on the bottom.


## STEP 3:

Sew on the marked lines. Press the background pieces away from the center of the heart as shown. Trim away the excess.


## STEP 4:

Sew the two sides of the heart together to form a heart.


STEP 5:

Add the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips of background fabric on the top and bottom of the heart unit. Then add the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ of background fabric strips on the right and the left. Square the block to measure 8".


Press the block.


## ALTERNATE DESIGNS:

- INSTEAD of using six $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips of fabric in STEP 1 , use.....
- One $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7$ " square of strip pieced fabric, Cut in half to make two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.


## OR

- Two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ fabric strips of the same or different colors

Then continue with STEP 2 as written.
