Wonky Churn Dash Block

| Fabric | Notes |
| :--- | :--- |
| $9-5^{\prime \prime}$ squares | White or White on White |
| $4-3^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles in Color A | Colors A and B should be cool colors - Purples, Blues, <br> Greens |
| $4-4^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles in Color B |  |

Make the sides of the Churn Dash - Lay one Color A block over a background square at an angle so that the right side of the Color A block is more than halfway to the right of the background square. Make sure right sides are together and pin in place.


Sew a quarter inch away from the right edge of Color A.
Trim the white fabric away and press open to the dark side.
Using the white portion as a guide, trim the excess Color A fabric back to a 5" square.

Make 4.


Make the corners of the churn dash.

Lay one Color B block over a background square at an angle so that the right side of the Color A block is more than halfway to the right of the background square. Make sure right sides are together.


Sew a quarter inch away from the right edge of Color A.
Trim the white fabric away and press open to the dark side.
Using the white portion as a guide, trim the excess Color B fabric back to a 5 " square.

Make 4.


You should have 4 side pieces in Color $\mathrm{A}, 4$ corner pieces in Color $B$, and one white square. Lay them out into a nine-patch churn dash with your remaining white square in the middle. Sew together the nine patch.
